## GLEN DAVID DRIVE - O'HARA TOWNSHIP, PA

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Glen David Drive in O'Hara Township is a heavily cracked residential cul-de-sac that leads to Chapel Gate Swim Club. The O'Hara Township Engineer was looking to **extend the life of the pavements and reduce reflective and alligator cracking**. The pilot project using FORTA-FI<sup>®</sup> split the road down the middle. One lane has a 3" leveling course and a 1-1/2" wearing course without fiber, while the other lane uses FORTAfi<sup>®</sup> asphalt for

After 4 years, **the FORTAfi<sup>®</sup> asphalt shows minimal signs of cracking** compared to the asphalt with no fiber.
