



RUBY'S DINER - COSTA MESA, CA

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Ruby's location on 17th Ave in East Side Costa Mesa had a heavily cracked parking lot in need of repair before the store itself received a new look. With areas of alligator cracking throughout, there was some concern about the structural integrity of the existing asphalt. Not wanting to remove and replace the entire lot, FORTA-FI[®] was chosen to reinforce a 1.5" overlay and increase the longevity of the repair. The approach also allowed a reduction in size of the digout areas.

UPDATE

2 years after construction, the **overlay is performing very well and even the trash enclosure pavement shows no sign of deterioration.**
