



HOCKEN ROAD - BEAVERTON, OR

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This was the City of Beaverton's first trial project with FORTA-FI[®] and they wanted to put it to the test on the difficult project of resurfacing Hocken Road. This is a busy artery next to one of the main commercial malls in the city, and it has historically had significant cracking and rutting issues. This was a 4" mill & fill because of the severity of the pavement distresses. **The production, placement and compaction of the FORTA[®] fiber asphalt went very well, with the city now specifying FORTA-FI[®] on many of their future overlay projects.**
